

ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY



Aghadoe Heights Hotel is committed to operating to the highest environmental standards possible to protect and sustain the natural environment, our employees, our community, and the long-term viability of our business. Our sustainability approach is embedded in daily operations and aligned with recognised best practice and all relevant environmental regulations.

Our Sustainability Vision is to minimise our environmental footprint while maximising our positive contribution to the local economy. We prioritise responsible resource management, continuous improvement, and transparent performance measurement. We regularly measure and monitor our impact with a focus on reducing energy and water consumption, minimising waste, and supporting local suppliers.

Key Objectives (2027–2030)

- **Energy Efficiency:** Reduce energy consumption by 5% in 2027, progressing toward a 30% reduction by 2028.
- **Water Conservation:** Reduce mains water usage by 5% in 2028.
- **Waste Reduction:** Achieve the Plastic Smart Greenmark by eliminating unnecessary single-use plastics.
- **Local Procurement:** Measure and increase purchasing from suppliers within a 100km radius.
- **Certification:** Achieve Eco-label Certification under the Green Hospitality Programme.

Carbon Neutrality Goal (2030) We aim to operate as a carbon-neutral hotel by reducing Scope 1 and 2 emissions, purchasing green electricity and Bio LPG, implementing ongoing energy-efficiency measures, offsetting corporate travel, and engaging suppliers to reduce their own emissions.

Responsible Sourcing We are committed to supporting local producers, with the majority of our food miles within 100km of the hotel. All additional purchases are assessed for responsible business practices and environmental performance.

Continuous Improvement All targets are reviewed annually, with new performance thresholds set to ensure alignment with national benchmarks and evolving best practice in sustainable hospitality.
